

POLICIES PERTAINING TO BUSINESS AND SUPPORT SERVICES

PEST CONTROL

The School periodically applies pesticides as part of an integrated pest management program. All persons applying pesticides at the School are required to receive special training in pesticide application and pest control. It is the policy of the School to use non-chemical pest control tactics whenever possible. All pest control services shall be conducted in accordance with the most current Structural Pest Control Board Integrated Pest Management Document. Employees shall be notified of pest control actions by notice posted on the office bulletin board. The School shall designate an employee to serve as the Integrated Pest Management (IPM) Coordinator. The IPM Coordinator shall be responsible for maintaining records of pesticide applications, and material safety data sheets. The IPM Coordinator shall also be responsible for posting the required notices and receiving requests for pest control services from School personnel. Any commercial pest control services employed by the School shall be properly certified and shall comply with all rules established by the Texas Structural Pest Control Board and applicable state laws.
