Triumph Public High Schools is making public notice for applying for the Elementary, Secondary School Emergency Relief (ESSER II) under the 2020-2022 Coronavirus Response and Relief Supplemental Appropriations (CRRSA) federal funding. CRRSA federal appropriations are being made available to local education agencies that are earmarked to:

- Address the impact of COVID pandemic and disruptions leading to learning loss.
- Mental Health and Behavioral Supports, social/emotional services.
- Extended Instructional Time: extended day, extended year, summer learning.

- Facilities: ventilation, HVAC systems, improve air-qualify.
- Staffing: tutors, reduced class sizes, small group instruction, staff retention, after school enrichment programs, instructional coaching and leadership.
