Endorsement Options

A student must complete the Foundation High School Program (22 credits), one additional math credit, one (1) additional science credit, and two (2) additional elective credits while complete the specific requirements of his/her selected endorsement. Distinguished Level of Achievement graduates must meet the Foundation Program and earn four (4) Math credits including Algebra II, four (4) Science credits, and at least one (1) Endorsement.
