TPHS El Paso West will need to: allocate dedicated time for teacher training on targeted instructional strategies and implementing HQIM/OER; increase time for structured PLCs or collaborative planning sessions, particularly focus on Unit/Module/Lesson Internalization; build time into the calendar for frequent classroom observations and feedback cycles, as outlined in our coaching protocols; reallocate funds to purchase HQIM/OER materials for Bluebonnet Algebra 1 and Odell Education (RLA 9-12); utilize LASO Grant Cycle 3 funds to support instructional coaching and curriculum internalization efforts; hire or reallocate staff to cover gaps in our new curriculum internalization processes.
