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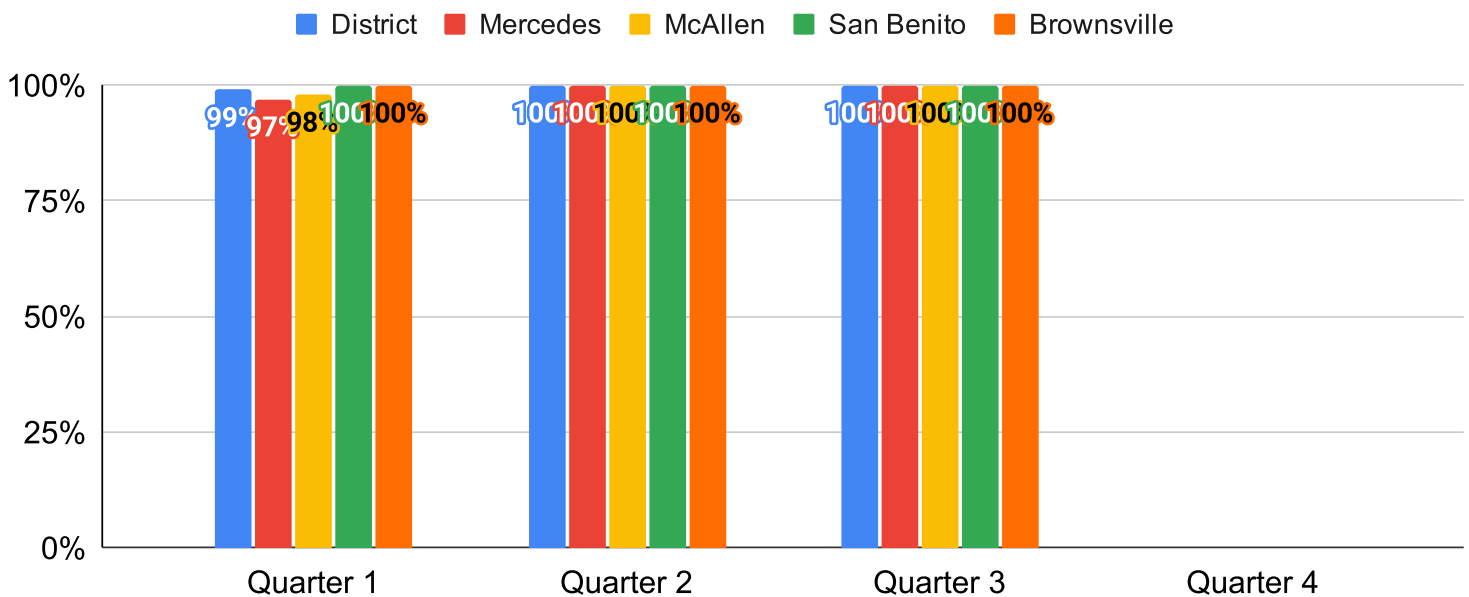

Goal 1: The percentage of graduates who will achieve college, career, or military readiness will increase from 22% (2021) to 70% by November 2026.

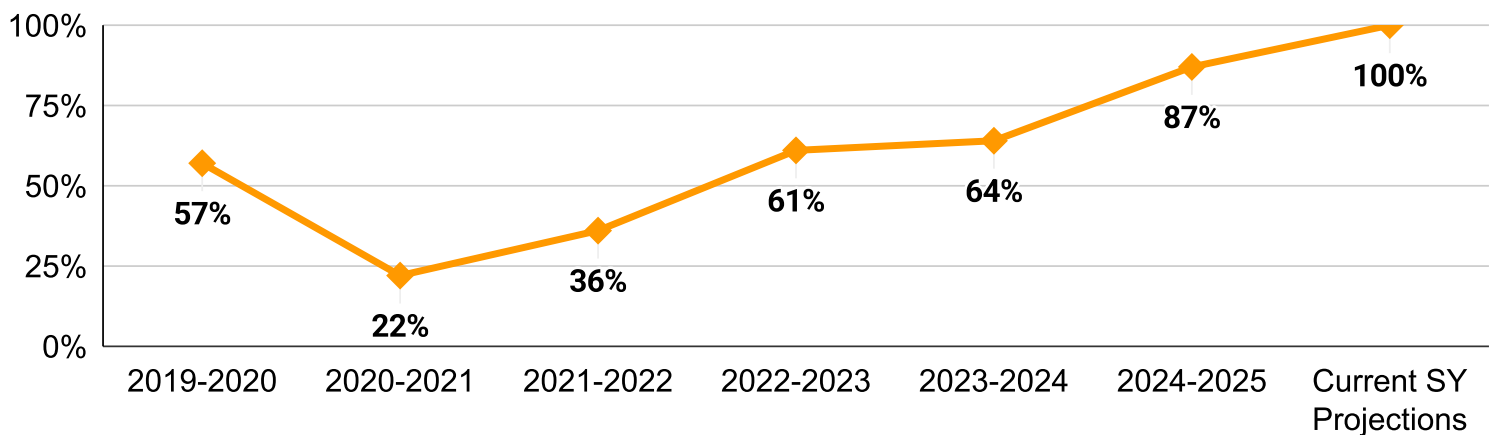

The plan moving forward into next Quarter is to:

- **CCMR Finalization & PEIMS Submission Readiness:** The primary focus for the remainder of the school year is the finalization, validation, and protection of earned CCMR indicators prior to PEIMS submission deadlines. Campuses will conduct final audits of IBC attainment, aligned coursework completion, TSIA2 indicators, military enlistment documentation, dual credit completion, and program of study course completion to ensure all eligible CCMR indicators are accurately coded and reported
- **IBC Results Monitoring & Retesting Closure:** Campuses will continue monitoring final IBC testing results and coordinate remaining retesting opportunities where allowable. Students currently enrolled in IBC-aligned CTE coursework must successfully complete both the course and credential requirements to generate CCMR credit under Accountability standards. Weekly monitoring of testing results and completion statuses will continue through the close of the testing windows.
- **Graduation Readiness & FHSP Verification:** Graduation verification remains the highest operational priority through the end of the school year. Campuses will continue transcript audits, credit verification, attendance monitoring, and credit recovery support to ensure seniors successfully meet Foundation High School Program (FHSP) graduation requirements while protecting CCMR attainment opportunities.
- **CCMR Data Reflection & Accountability Readiness:** District and campus leadership teams will analyze preliminary CCMR outcome trends, participation rates, credential attainment data, and subgroup performance to identify strengths, barriers, and areas requiring additional support heading into the 2026–2027 school year. Findings will inform future CCMR planning, intervention systems, and resource allocation decisions.
- **Career Readiness Expansion & Program Alignment:** Campuses and district leadership will review current career-readiness offerings, industry-based certifications, and aligned programs of study to identify opportunities for expansion, regional alignment, and improved student access during the 2026–2027 school year. Emphasis will be placed on strengthening pathways that generate the highest student participation and successful credential attainment.
