The certification must be approved by a majority of the charter holder's Board of Directors at a public meeting that provides an opportunity for public testimony and for which notice has been posted on the school's website at least seven calendar days in advance.

Board Action: The Board approved the Board Resolution for Compliance with Texas Education Code §§11.005 and 28.0022 as presented, authorizing the Superintendent to complete and submit the required certification to the Texas Education Agency and to post the adopted resolution and meeting minutes on the school's website in accordance with state law.
